Title: **Procedure for Cleaning Bulk Water Tanks**

1. Contracted services bringing bulk tanks to the farm are responsible for cleaning and maintenance of tanks at their place of business- not at this farm.
2. Tanks used and maintained at this farm must:
 - a. Be labeled as non-potable water
 - b. Be labeled as to contents, example water, fertilizer, chemical, etc.
 - c. Chemicals will carry a full label on the tank.
 - d. All empty tanks will be triple washed and water will be drained and contained away from any production area.
 - e. Upon refilling, non-potable water tanks will be shocked with food grade chlorine at a rate according to SOP 2.01
 - f. Certain tanks may be returned or disposed of according to manufacturer's label.
